## Sewing Supply List for Pillow Project

These materials are due in class on
FABRIC 100% Cotton (NO Jersey Knit, Silky, etc.) Take your <u>Final Design</u> sheet for the Pillow Project with your notes about how much of each fabric to get. If you do not find fabric that you like or what you thought you'd want for a specific part of your pillow pattern, choose another fabric to replace the pattern.
THREAD All Purpose Thread (Not Silky or Quilting) Pick a color that will match your pillow—if you have several colors in your pillow, match the thread to a <i>darker</i> color.
MUSLIN A firm plain-weave cotton fabric that is either white or off white and found in a variety of weights. (Cheap is ok, it is the pillow lining—You will not see it once the pillow is finished.) You will need 2 YARDS for our first project.
STUFFING You will need 2 Large BAGS of filling for your pillow. (Example: Morning Glory fiberfil, NOT batting)
**ALL FABRIC NEEDS TO BE PRE-WASHED AND IRONED BEFORE COMING TO CLASS – ONCE THE PROJECT IS STARTED, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WASH THE MATERIAL IN CLASS.**
Cut off this section and return onfor 2 points extra credit that will be added onto the Pillow Project.

## Dear Parents,

We will be starting our first construction project of the term in Textiles and Design 1 soon.
